Susan Telford rejoins the MMR faculty for the 2015 season. With degrees from the University of Washington and Northwestern University (where she received Program Honors) and additional studies at Music Academy of the West, she was the winner of several competitions,.

Susie has been a member of the Tacoma Symphony, Elgin Symphony, Evansville Philharmonic, Bellevue Philharmonic, Chicago Chamber Orchestra, as well as a substitute with the Seattle Symphony, Seattle Opera, Pacific Northwest Ballet, several chamber groups, and nearly every major ensemble in the Seattle area. She performs regularly with Saratoga Orchestra of Whidbey and the Auburn Symphony.

With the ensemble Quake and a child in tow she performed at the Pacific Rim Music Festival in California, the CrossSound Festival in Alaska, and the Music Biennale Zagreb. She was recently featured with the North Corner Chamber Orchestra, as well as premiering new works with the Universal Language Project and on the Wayward Music Series.

As a studio musician she has performed on countless movie and game soundtracks and various other projects. In addition to her private flute students, she has served as artist/faculty of several institutions, including the University of Evansville, Midsummer Musical Retreat, Marrowstone in the City, and Southern Illinois Music Festival.
